



Proponent Testimony for HB 2114
House Committee on Corrections & Juvenile Justice
February 2, 2023

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of **HB 2114: renaming the Joint Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice Oversight in honor of Representative J. Russell (Russ) Jennings and requiring the committee to monitor the implementation of juvenile justice reforms.**

Russ and I were part of the same freshman class of lawmakers elected in 2012. He was a consummate statesman, but also my best friend under the dome. As so many others can attest, he was a tremendous mentor and coach. He brought a wealth of experience in government service, including time serving on the Kansas Children's Cabinet as an ex officio member during his tenure as head of the Juvenile Justice Authority, to the legislative process and Kansas is better off because of it. The major restructuring of the juvenile justice system in Kansas is central to his legacy.
