

HB 2618---Summary

HB 2618 revises the election crime of false representation of an election official to delete:

“engaging in conduct that gives the appearance of being an election official”. (arguably a subjective standard)

The bill also adds the element of “intent” to : “engaging in conduct “with the intent to cause a person” to believe the person is an election official.

A severity level 7, nonperson felony carries a sentence of presumptive probation unless the person has two prior person felony convictions.
