
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2059 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2059 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2059 would amend the common consumption area law to allow, rather than require, that roads be blocked and permit signage to designate those areas.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates the enactment of HB 2059 could increase revenues to counties from additional application fees, provided that enforcement costs would not exceed new revenues. The League of Kansas Municipalities indicates the enactment of HB 2059 would have no fiscal effect.
