1 AN ACT concerning the law enforcement memorial advisory committee;
2 expanding the membership thereof; amending K.S.A. 75-2251 and
3 repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 75-2251 is hereby amended to read as follows: 75-
7 2251. (a) There is hereby established the law enforcement officers
8 memorial advisory committee, which shall be composed of ~~40~~ 11 members
9 as follows:

10 (1) A representative of the Kansas peace officers association,
11 appointed by the governor;

12 (2) a representative of the Kansas chiefs of police, appointed by the
13 governor;

14 (3) a representative of the Kansas fraternal order of police, appointed
15 by the governor;

16 (4) a representative of the Kansas state troopers association,
17 appointed by the governor;

18 (5) a representative of the Kansas sheriffs' association, appointed by
19 the governor;

20 (6) *a representative of the Kansas chapter of concerns of police*
21 *survivors, appointed by the governor;*

22 (7) the director of the Kansas bureau of investigation, or the director's
23 designee;

24 ~~(7)~~(8) the superintendent of the Kansas highway patrol, or the
25 superintendent's designee;

26 ~~(8)~~(9) the attorney general, or the attorney general's designee;

27 ~~(9)~~(10) the secretary of the state historical society, or the secretary's
28 designee; and

29 ~~(10)~~(11) the secretary of corrections, or the secretary's designee.

30 (b) With regard to a member to be appointed by the governor as
31 representative of the Kansas peace officers association, the Kansas chiefs
32 of police, the Kansas fraternal order of police, the Kansas state troopers
33 association ~~or~~, the Kansas sheriffs' association *or the Kansas chapter of*
34 *concerns of police survivors*, the association or group to be represented

1 may submit a list of at least three names for consideration by the governor
2 in making the appointment. The governor shall consider each such list if
3 timely submitted and may appoint from among those listed.

4 (c) The law enforcement officers memorial advisory committee shall
5 be advisory to the director of architectural services and the secretary of the
6 state historical society with regard to matters concerning the memorial to
7 law enforcement officers on the state capitol grounds. The advisory
8 committee may also make recommendations to the governor and the
9 legislature regarding appropriate activities memorializing or
10 commemorating the services of law enforcement officers in Kansas. The
11 advisory committee may solicit grants, gifts, contributions and bequests
12 for the memorial and shall remit all moneys so received to the state
13 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
14 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
15 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit
16 of the law enforcement memorial fund.

17 (d) The members of the advisory committee shall organize annually
18 by electing a chairperson and ~~vice chairperson~~ *vice chairperson*. The
19 advisory committee shall meet at least once each year upon call of the
20 chairperson. The secretary of the state historical society, or the secretary's
21 designee, shall serve as secretary for the advisory committee. Members of
22 the advisory committee appointed by the governor under this section shall
23 serve at the pleasure of the governor.

24 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 75-2251 is hereby repealed.

25 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
26 publication in the statute book.
