AN ACT concerning corrections; relating to a day reporting center in Wyandotte county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

Section 1. (a) The department of corrections shall establish a day reporting center in Wyandotte county.

(b) If the unified government board of commissioners of Wyandotte county objects to the proposed location of such day reporting center and the unified government actively assists the secretary of corrections in identifying a suitable location for such day reporting center within Wyandotte county, with consideration of the site selection criteria established for such day reporting center and applicable zoning and other land-use restrictions of Wyandotte county, then, prior to establishing such day reporting center, the secretary of corrections shall actively consider the views of the unified government board of commissioners of Wyandotte county and the affected residents of Wyandotte county. The secretary shall act in the best interests of the state with regard to establishing such day reporting center. No objections by the unified government board of commissioners or the residents of Wyandotte county shall prohibit establishment of such day reporting center within Wyandotte county.

(c) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the day reporting center shall not be subject to local zoning, permit, licensure, or other local operating requirements or conditions.

(d) The center shall provide supervision, counseling, and monitoring services to those offenders on parole or postrelease supervision who are referred to the center pursuant to policies of the department of corrections.

(e) The department of corrections may contract with a qualified entity for the operation of the day reporting center.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
