9 AN ACT relating to salvage vehicle dealers; providing for buyer's iden-
10 tification cards.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) Any person licensed as a salvage vehicle dealer under
14 K.S.A. 8-2401 *et seq.*, and amendments thereto, who wishes to purchase
15 nonrepairable vehicles, as defined in K.S.A. 8-135c, and amendments
16 thereto, or salvage vehicles, as defined in K.S.A. 8-197, and amendments
17 thereto, at an auction or salvage vehicle pool, shall make application to
18 the division for a buyer's identification card. The application shall be on
19 a form prescribed by the director and shall contain the applicant's name,
20 principal business address, the license number under which the applicant
21 will be making purchases and such other information as the director may
22 require. In lieu of directly obtaining a buyer's identification card or in
23 addition thereto, any person licensed as a salvage vehicle dealer, may
24 designate up to two employees to act as buyers for the licensee. The
25 licensee shall make application for a buyer's identification card for each
26 employee in the same manner as for a card for the licensee.

27 (b) Sales of nonrepairable vehicles or salvage vehicles at auctions or
28 salvage vehicle pools, shall be opened only to persons possessing a Kansas
29 buyers identification card as provided in subsection (a).

30 (c) An annual \$10 fee shall be charged for each identification card
31 issued.

32 (d) A buyer's identification card is nontransferable. If the holder of a
33 card no longer possesses a valid salvage dealer license or if an employee
34 of the licensee leaves the employment of the licensee, the buyer's iden-
35 tification card of that person is invalid and the holder shall return the
36 card to the division.

37 (e) Any person who holds a valid salvage vehicle dealer's license from
38 another state that imposes qualifications and requirements with respect
39 to the license that are equivalent to those required by K.S.A. 8-2401, *et*
40 *seq.*, and amendments thereto, may make application to the director who
41 shall, based upon the director's investigation, issue a buyer's identification
42 card to those applicants who the director determines are qualified.

43 (f) A buyer's identification card may be denied, suspended or revoked

1 or a renewal may be refused by the director on any of the applicable
2 grounds listed in K.S.A. 8-2410, and amendments thereto. In addition,
3 the director may revoke or suspend the license of a salvage vehicle dealer
4 who allows such dealer's buyer's identification card or the buyer's iden-
5 tification card of an employee to be used by any unauthorized person.

6 (g) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the vehicle
7 dealers and manufacturers licensing act.

8 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
9 publication in the statute book.
