9 AN ACT concerning session laws; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 45-107  
10 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 45-107 is hereby amended to read as  
14 follows: 45-107. (a) The secretary of state shall sell copies of the session  
15 laws at the per volume price for such copies fixed by the secretary of state  
16 under this section. The secretary of state shall remit all moneys received  
17 under this section to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions  
18 of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such  
19 remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state  
20 treasury to the credit of the state general fund.

21 (b) Whenever the inventory of copies of any volume of the session  
22 laws exceeds 100 and a later volume of the session laws has been pub-  
23 lished, the secretary of state may dispose of copies of such volume without  
24 making a charge therefor until the inventory of such volume is reduced  
25 to 100 copies. When the inventory of any volume of the session laws is  
26 100 copies or less, the secretary of state, with the approval of the revisor  
27 of statutes, may dispose of copies from such inventory without making a  
28 charge therefor.

29 (c) The secretary of state shall fix by rules and regulations the per  
30 volume price for copies of the session laws sold under this section to  
31 recover the costs of printing, binding and storing such volumes. The sec-  
32 retary of state shall revise all such prices from time to time as necessary  
33 for the purposes of covering and recovering such costs.

34 (d) *The secretary of state shall deliver one set of session laws to each*  
35 *county law library in the state upon the librarian's request.*

36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 45-107 is hereby repealed.

37 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
38 publication in the statute book.
