

## HOUSE BILL No. 2332

By Committee on Education

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9 AN ACT relating to schools; concerning school finance adjustments re-  
10 lating to pupils attending school in a school district where the pupils  
11 do not reside; amending K.S.A. 72-6412 and 72-6442 and repealing  
12 the existing sections.  
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14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 New Section 1. (a) As used in this section, “enrollment weight”  
16 means payments attributable to low enrollment weighting pursuant to  
17 K.S.A. 72-6412 and amendments thereto, and correlation weighting, pur-  
18 suant to K.S.A. 72-6426, and amendments thereto.

19 (b) For pupils residing in this state who do not meet the requirements  
20 of K.S.A. 72-1046, and amendments thereto, and who attend school in  
21 another school district in this state, the state board shall adjust the en-  
22rollment weight for the school district that is attributable to each such  
23 pupil. Such adjustment shall be made to pay the enrollment weight that  
24 is attributable to each pupil that would have been paid had the pupil  
25 attended the school district where the child resides if such amount is less  
26 than the amount paid to the school district where the pupil attends school.

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-6412 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-  
28 6412. *Subject to adjustments pursuant to section 1, and amendments*  
29 *thereto*, the low enrollment weighting of each district with under 1,725  
30 enrollment shall be determined by the state board as follows:

31 (a) Determine the amount of the median budget per pupil for the  
32 1991-92 school year of districts with 75-125 enrollment in such school  
33 year;

34 (b) determine the amount of the median budget per pupil for the  
35 1991-92 school year of districts with 200-399 enrollment in such school  
36 year;

37 (c) determine the amount of the median budget per pupil for the  
38 1991-92 school year of districts with 1,900 or over enrollment;

39 (d) prescribe a schedule amount for each of the districts by preparing  
40 a schedule based upon an accepted mathematical formula and derived  
41 from a linear transition between (1) the median budgets per pupil deter-  
42mined under (a) and (b), and (2) the median budgets per pupil deter-  
43mined under (b) and (c). The schedule amount for districts with 0-99

- 1 enrollment is an amount equal to the amount of the median budget per  
2 pupil determined under (a). The schedule amount for districts with 100-  
3 299 enrollment is the amount derived from the linear transition under  
4 (1). The schedule amount for districts with 300-1,899 enrollment is the  
5 amount derived from the linear transition under (2);
- 6 (e) for districts with 0-99 enrollment:
- 7 (1) Subtract the amount determined under (c) from the amount de-  
8 termined under (a);
- 9 (2) divide the remainder obtained under (1) by the amount deter-  
10 mined under (c);
- 11 (3) multiply the quotient obtained under (2) by the enrollment of the  
12 district in the current school year. The product is the low enrollment  
13 weighting of the district;
- 14 (f) for districts with 100-299 enrollment:
- 15 (1) Subtract the amount determined under (c) from the schedule  
16 amount of the district;
- 17 (2) divide the remainder obtained under (1) by the amount deter-  
18 mined under (c);
- 19 (3) multiply the quotient obtained under (2) by the enrollment of the  
20 district in the current school year. The product is the low enrollment  
21 weighting of the district;
- 22 (g) for districts with 300-1,724 enrollment:
- 23 (1) Subtract the amount determined under (c) from the schedule  
24 amount of the district;
- 25 (2) divide the remainder obtained under (1) by the amount deter-  
26 mined under (c);
- 27 (3) multiply the quotient obtained under (2) by the enrollment of the  
28 district in the current school year. The product is the low enrollment  
29 weighting of the district.
- 30 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 72-6442 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-  
31 6442. *Subject to adjustments pursuant to section 1, and amendments*  
32 *thereto*, the correlation weighting of each district with 1,725 or over en-  
33 rollment shall be determined by the state board as follows:
- 34 (a) Determine the schedule amount for a district with 1,725 enroll-  
35 ment as derived from the linear transition under (d) of K.S.A. 72-6412,  
36 and amendments thereto, and subtract the amount determined under (c)  
37 of K.S.A. 72-6412, and amendments thereto, from the schedule amount  
38 so determined;
- 39 (b) divide the remainder obtained under (a) by the amount deter-  
40 mined under (c) of K.S.A. 72-6412, and amendments thereto, and mul-  
41 tiple the quotient by the enrollment of the district in the current school  
42 year. The product is the correlation weighting of the district.
- 43 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 72-6412 and 72-6442 are hereby repealed.

1     Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
2     publication in the statute book.
