9 AN ACT concerning retired teachers; relating to the provision of notice
10 to such retirees of the availability of certain benefits.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. As used in this section:

14 (1) "Retired teachers' organization" is an organization having at least
15 2,500 dues-paying members who are retired teachers and which has en-
16 tered into an agreement with the executive director pursuant to this sec-
17 tion; and

18 (2) words and phrases used in this section shall have the meanings
19 ascribed thereto by K.S.A. 74-4902, and amendments thereto.

20 (b) The executive director, with the approval of the board of trustees,
21 may enter into agreements with any retired teachers' organization under
22 which the executive director mails or provides for the mailing of infor-
23 mation and materials to all teachers who have retired from the system.
24 Any such agreement may include any provision deemed necessary by the
25 executive director, but shall provide that:

26 (1) The executive director shall approve, prior to any mailing, the
27 format and content of the mailing;

28 (2) the system shall not be held responsible or liable for delays in a
29 mailing if such organization does not timely provide to the system ma-
30 terials for such mailing or materials which are not in sufficient quantities
31 to be mailed to all retired teachers;

32 (3) the retired teachers' organization shall provide to the executive
33 director all materials for any mailing and pay for all costs of the mailing
34 and any other costs incurred by the system or the executive director in
35 relation to the agreement or any mailing pursuant thereto; and

36 (4) the agreement is subject to immediate cancellation by the exec-
37 utive director, upon five-days written notice.

38 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
39 publication in the statute book.
