11 AN ACT prohibiting cities and counties from requiring that certain  
12 wages be paid.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. (a) On and after the effective date of this act, no governing  
16 body of any city of this state shall adopt an ordinance or enter into a  
17 contract or other agreement which requires any person contracting or  
18 entering into an agreement with the city, or any instrumentality of the  
19 city, to pay wages to the employees of such person in excess of the federal  
20 minimum hourly wage or state minimum hourly wage.

21 (b) On and after the effective date of this act, no board of county  
22 commissioners of any county of this state shall adopt a resolution or enter  
23 into a contract or other agreement which requires any person contracting  
24 or entering into an agreement with the county, or any instrumentality of  
25 the county, to pay wages to the employees of such person in excess of the  
26 federal minimum hourly wage or state minimum hourly wage.

27 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
28 publication in the statute book.
