

## SENATE BILL No. 141

9 AN ACT concerning elections; relating to lists of advance voters; amend-  
10 ing K.S.A. 25-1126 and 25-2320a and K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 25-2320 and  
11 repealing the existing sections.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-1126 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-  
15 1126. (a) A list of the names of all advance voting voters of the precinct  
16 from whom advance voting ballots have been received shall be given to  
17 the supervising judge with the voting supplies, and if additional advance  
18 voting ballots are received, the names of voters from whom they are  
19 received shall be promptly added to such list. Such list shall be available  
20 at the voting place at all times on election day.

21 (b) *The county election official shall compile and maintain a list of*  
22 *the names of all advance voters in the county. County election officials*  
23 *shall allow access to such list by any person in the same manner as pro-*  
24 *vided in K.S.A. 25-2320, and amendments thereto, for access to voter*  
25 *registration lists.*

26 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 25-2320 is hereby amended to read as  
27 follows: 25-2320. (a) The county election officer shall allow access to any  
28 person at any time during regular business hours, under supervision of  
29 the county election officer for the purpose of examining the voter regis-  
30 tration books, active voter lists, *advance voter lists* and other lists of voters  
31 required to be kept. Any person may make a written request for a copy  
32 of the registration books at any time except on any election day. The  
33 election officer is hereby directed to provide one or more copies which  
34 are accurate insofar as practicable of such books to the person so re-  
35 questing. The election officer shall provide such copies to the person  
36 within 10 days following the request if so requested. The expense of  
37 making such copies shall be paid by the person requesting them. The cost  
38 of copies shall be established by the county election officer at a price  
39 which is not more than the actual cost and shall be set uniformly in order  
40 that the price therefor shall be the same for all persons requesting iden-  
41 tical copies.

42 (b) No voter registration record *or advance voting list* shall be made  
43 available for public inspection or copying unless the individual's social

1 security number, or any part thereof, has been removed or otherwise been  
2 rendered unreadable.

3 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 25-2320a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-  
4 2320a. Use of voter registration lists *or advance voter lists* for commercial  
5 purposes is knowingly selling, giving or receiving the information on or  
6 derived from voter registration lists *or advance voter lists* with the intent  
7 to use such list or information for any commercial purpose.

8 Use of voter registration lists *or advance voter lists* for commercial  
9 purposes is a class C misdemeanor. For purposes of this section, com-  
10 piling, using, giving, receiving, selling or purchasing the information on  
11 or derived from voter registration lists *or advance voter lists*, solely for  
12 political campaign or election purposes, shall not constitute a commercial  
13 use of voter registration lists *or advance voter lists*.

14 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 25-1126 and 25-2320a and K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 25-2320  
15 are hereby repealed.

16 Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
17 publication in the statute book.
