9 AN ACT concerning the department of corrections; relating to funding
10 for department of corrections offender substance abuse treatment pro-
11 grams; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-7336 and repealing the existing
12 section.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby amended to read as
16 follows: 74-7336. (a) Of the remittances of fines, penalties and forfeitures
17 received from clerks of the district court, at least monthly, the state trea-
18 surer shall credit 11.99% to the crime victims compensation fund, 2.45%
19 to the crime victims assistance fund, 2.01% to the community alcoholism
20 and intoxication programs fund, ~~2.01%~~ and 7.6% during fiscal year 2006
21 and 4.98% thereafter to the department of corrections alcohol and drug
22 abuse treatment fund. The remainder of the remittances shall be credited
23 to the state general fund.

24 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit grant moneys as provided in
25 subsection (a), from the crime victims assistance fund, to the credit of a
26 special fund created for use by the county or district attorney in estab-
27 lishing and maintaining programs to aid witnesses and victims of crime.

28 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby repealed.

29 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30 publication in the statute book.
