9 AN ACT concerning counties; relating to the office of county adminis-
10 trator; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 19-3a02 and repealing the existing
11 section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 19-3a02 is hereby amended to read as
15 follows: 19-3a02. (a) The board of county commissioners of any county
16 may adopt a resolution establishing the office of county administrator.

17 (b) The board of county commissioners of any county may adopt a
18 resolution submitting to the voters of the county whether the county
19 should adopt a resolution establishing the office of county administrator.
20 Such resolution to establish the office of county administrator shall not
21 be effective until the question has been submitted to and approved by a
22 majority of the voters of the county voting at an election thereon. Such
23 election shall be called and held in the manner provided by the general
24 bond law.

25 (c) Upon presentation of a petition requesting the establishment of
26 the office of county administrator signed by at least ~~5%~~ 3% of the qualified
27 electors of the county, the board of county commissioners shall adopt a
28 resolution establishing such office. Such resolution shall not be effective
29 until the question has been submitted to and approved by a majority of
30 the voters of the county voting at an election thereon. Such election shall
31 be called and held in the manner provided by the general bond law.

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 19-3a02 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
34 publication in the statute book.
