9 AN ACT concerning accessibility standards for public buildings or facil-
10 ities; relating to the enforcement thereof; amending K.S.A. 2004 Supp.
11 58-1304 and repealing the existing section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 58-1304 is hereby amended to read as
15 follows: 58-1304. (a) The responsibility for enforcement of this act shall
16 be as follows:

17 (1) For all existing Title II school facilities, and the design and con-
18 struction of all new, additions to and alterations of Title II school facilities,
19 the state board of education, by plan approval as required by K.S.A. 31-
20 150, and amendments thereto. Facilities operated or used for any purpose
21 by, or located upon the land of any community college, area vocational
22 school, area vocational-technical school, technical college, or institution
23 under the governance of the state board of regents shall not be subject
24 to the provisions of this subsection;

25 (2) for all existing state government facilities, and the design and con-
26 struction of all new, additions to and alterations of, facilities for which
27 federal, state, county funds or funds of other political subdivisions of the
28 state or private funds are utilized on state property, the secretary of
29 administration;

30 (3) for all existing facilities, and the design and construction of all
31 new, additions to and alterations of, any local government facilities where
32 funds of a county, municipality or other political subdivision are utilized,
33 the governmental entity thereof or an agency thereof designated by the
34 governmental entity;

35 (4) for the design and construction of all other new, additions to and
36 alterations of, facilities which are subject to the provisions of this act, the
37 building inspector or other agency or person designated by the govern-
38 mental entity in which the facility is located.

39 (b) The attorney general of the state of Kansas shall *appoint an ad-*
40 *ditional assistant attorney general and appoint or contract to utilize the*
41 *services of other persons as the attorney general deems necessary to over-*
42 *see the enforcement of this act.*

43 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2004 Supp. 58-1304 is hereby repealed.

2 publication in the Kansas register.
