9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas offender registration act; relating to res-  
10 idency restrictions.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for an offender to reside within  
14 1,000 feet of a licensed child care facility or registered family day care  
15 home or 1,500 feet of the real property of any school upon which is  
16 located a structure used by a unified school district or an accredited non-  
17 public school for student instruction or attendance or extracurricular ac-  
18 tivities of pupils enrolled in kindergarten or any grades one through 12.

19 (b) Violation of this section is a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

20 (c) This section shall not apply to any of the following:

21 (1) An offender who is serving a sentence at any state correctional  
22 institution or facility, conservation camp, state security hospital, juvenile  
23 correctional facility, community correction center or facility for detention  
24 or confinement, juvenile detention facility or jail.

25 (2) An offender who is subject to an order of commitment pursuant  
26 to K.S.A. 59-29a01 et seq., and amendments thereto.

27 (3) An offender who has established a residence prior to July 1, 2006,  
28 or a school, licensed child care facility or registered family day care home  
29 is newly located on or after July 1, 2006.

30 (4) An offender who is a minor or a ward under a guardianship.

31 (d) For purposes of this section:

32 (1) "Offender" means a person who is an offender as defined in  
33 K.S.A. 22-4902, and amendments thereto, and the criminal conviction  
34 which requires the offender to register was against a victim or involved a  
35 party who was less than 18 years of age.

36 (2) "Residence" means the place where a person sleeps, which may  
37 include more than one location, and may be mobile or transitory.

38 (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas of-  
39 fender registration act.

40 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
41 publication in the statute book.
