10 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning auxiliary driving lamps; amending
11 K.S.A. 8-1728 and repealing the existing section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-1728 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-
15 1728. (a) At all times specified in K.S.A. 8-1703, *and amendments thereto*,
16 at least two ~~(2)~~ lighted head lamps shall be displayed, one ~~(1)~~ on each
17 side at the front of every motor vehicle, except when such vehicle is
18 parked, subject to the regulations governing lights on parked vehicles.

19 (b) Whenever a motor vehicle equipped with head lamps as herein
20 required is also equipped with any auxiliary lamps or a spot lamp or any
21 other lamp on the front thereof projecting a beam of intensity greater
22 than ~~three hundred (300)~~ 300 candlepower, not more than a total of four
23 ~~(4)~~ of any such lamps on the front of a vehicle shall be lighted at any one
24 time when upon a highway.

25 (c) *Whenever a motor vehicle is equipped with auxiliary driving*
26 *lamps, such lamps shall not be used as a substitute for headlamps or*
27 *lighted at any time the headlamps are required to be on in the low-beam*
28 *position.*

29 **[(d) From and after the effective date of this act, and prior to**
30 **July 1, 2007, a law enforcement officer shall issue a warning cita-**
31 **tion to anyone violating subsection (c).]**

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1728 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
34 publication in the statute book.
