9 AN ACT concerning legal public holidays; amending K.S.A. 2005 Supp.
10 35-107 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. *On and after January 1, 2007*, K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 35-107
14 is hereby amended to read as follows: 35-107. (a) ~~On and after January~~
15 ~~1, 2006~~, The following days are declared to be legal public holidays and
16 are to be observed as such:

17 New Year's Day, January 1;

18 Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, the third Monday in January;

19 President's Day, the third Monday in February;

20 Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;

21 Independence Day, July 4;

22 Labor Day, the first Monday in September;

23 Columbus Day, the second Monday in October;

24 Veterans' Day, ~~the eleventh day in~~ November 11;

25 Thanksgiving Day, the fourth Thursday in November;

26 Christmas Day, December 25.

27 (b) *If a day declared as a legal holiday by subsection (a) falls on a*
28 *Saturday, the Friday immediately before is the legal holiday. If a day*
29 *declared as a legal holiday by subsection (a) falls on a Sunday, the Monday*
30 *immediately after is the legal holiday.*

31 (c) Any reference in the laws of this state concerning observance of
32 legal holidays shall *on and after January 1, 2006*, be considered as a
33 reference to the day or days prescribed in subsection (a) for the obser-
34 vance of such legal holiday or holidays.

35 (d) *All state departments and agencies, including the legislature and*
36 *its agencies, shall observe the holidays provided by this section and no*
37 *agency shall have authority to change any such holiday by rules and*
38 *regulations or otherwise.*

39 Sec. 2. On and after January 1, 2007, K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 35-107 is
40 hereby repealed.

41 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
42 publication in the statute book.
