9 AN ACT concerning state gaming revenues; relating to disposition;
10 amending K.S.A. 79-4801 and K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 79-4806 and repeal-
11 ing the existing sections.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 79-4801 is hereby amended to read as follows: 79-
15 4801. There is hereby created the state gaming revenues fund in the state
16 treasury. All moneys credited to such fund shall be expended or trans-
17 ferred only for the purposes and in the manner provided by this act and
18 all expenditures from the state gaming revenues fund shall be made in
19 accordance with appropriation acts. All moneys credited to such fund shall
20 be allocated and credited monthly to the funds and in the amounts spec-
21 ified by this act except that the total of the amounts credited to such
22 funds in any one fiscal year pursuant to this act shall not exceed
23 ~~\$50,000,000~~ \$53,000,000. All amounts credited to such fund in any one
24 fiscal year which are in excess of ~~\$50,000,000~~ \$53,000,000 shall be trans-
25 ferred and credited to the state general fund on July 15, 1996, and June
26 25, 1997, and each year thereafter on June 25 of each year.

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 79-4806 is hereby amended to read as
28 follows: 79-4806. On July 1 of each year or as soon thereafter as sufficient
29 moneys are available, ~~\$80,000~~ \$3,080,000 credited to the state gaming
30 revenues fund shall be transferred and credited to the problem gambling
31 grant fund established by K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 79-4805, and amendments
32 thereto.

33 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 79-4801 and K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 79-4806 are hereby
34 repealed.

35 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July
36 1, 2007, and its publication in the statute book.
