10 AN ACT concerning wildlife and parks; relating to funding therefor; con-
11 cerning the economic development initiatives **state gaming revenues**
12 **fund; creating the local government outdoor recreation grant pro-**
13 **gram fund;** amending K.S.A. 79-4801 and K.S.A. 2005 Supp. 79-4804
14 and repealing the existing sections **section.**

16 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

17 New Section 1. (a) There is hereby created in the state treasury the
18 local government outdoor recreation grant program fund. Moneys cred-
19 ited to such fund shall be used for the purpose of implementing the
20 provisions of K.S.A. 32-1201 through 32-1203, and amendments thereto.
21 All expenditures from the local government outdoor recreation grant pro-
22 gram fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts, upon
23 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouch-
24 ers approved by the secretary of wildlife and parks.

25 (b) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the Kansas
26 local government outdoor recreation grant program act.

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 79-4801 is hereby amended to read as follows: 79-
28 4801. (a) There is hereby created the state gaming revenues fund in the
29 state treasury. All moneys credited to such fund shall be expended or
30 transferred only for the purposes and in the manner provided by this act
31 and all expenditures from the state gaming revenues fund shall be made
32 in accordance with appropriation acts. All moneys credited to such fund
33 shall be allocated and credited monthly to the funds and in the amounts
34 specified by this act except that the total of the amounts credited to such
35 funds in any one fiscal year pursuant to this act shall not exceed
36 ~~\$50,000,000~~ \$55,000,000. All amounts credited to such fund in any one
37 fiscal year which are in excess of ~~\$50,000,000~~ \$55,000,000 shall be trans-
38 ferred and credited to the state general fund on July 15, 1996, and June
39 ~~25, 1997,~~ and each year thereafter on June 25.

40 (b) **In each fiscal year commencing the fiscal year ending June**
41 **30, 2007, the director of accounts and reports shall make transfers**
42 **in equal amounts on October 15, December 15, March 15 and June**
43 **15 of each fiscal year which in the aggregate equal \$4,000,000 from**

1 *the state gaming revenues fund to the parks fee fund, created by*
2 *K.S.A. 32-991, and amendments thereto. If sufficient moneys from*
3 *the state gaming revenues fund are not available, the director of*
4 *accounts and reports on such date or as soon thereafter as moneys*
5 *become available in the state general fund, shall transfer an amount*
6 *equal to such insufficiency from the state general fund to the parks*
7 *fee fund.*

8 (c) *In each fiscal year commencing the fiscal year ending June*
9 *30, 2007, the director of accounts and reports shall make a transfer*
10 *on August 15 of each fiscal year in the amount of \$1,000,000 from*
11 *the state gaming revenues fund to the local government outdoor*
12 *recreation grant program fund, created by section 1, and amend-*
13 *ments thereto. If sufficient moneys from the state gaming revenues*
14 *fund are not available, the director of accounts and reports on such*
15 *date or as soon thereafter as moneys become available in the state*
16 *general fund, shall transfer an amount equal to such insufficiency*
17 *from the state general fund to the local government outdoor recre-*
18 *ation grant program fund.*

20 ~~follows: 79-4804. (a) After the transfer of moneys pursuant to K.S.A. 2005~~
21 ~~Supp. 79-4806, and amendments thereto, an amount equal to 85% of the~~
22 ~~balance of all moneys credited to the state gaming revenues fund shall~~
23 ~~be transferred and credited to the state economic development initiatives~~
24 ~~fund. Expenditures from the state economic development initiatives fund~~
25 ~~shall be made in accordance with appropriations acts for the financing of~~
26 ~~such programs supporting and enhancing the existing economic founda-~~
27 ~~tion of the state and fostering growth through the expansion of current,~~
28 ~~and the establishment and attraction of new, commercial and industrial~~

36 ~~the state economic development initiatives fund. All moneys credited to~~
37 ~~the Kansas capital formation account shall be used to provide, encourage~~
38 ~~and implement capital development and formation in Kansas.~~

39 ~~—(c)—There is hereby created the Kansas economic development re-~~
40 ~~search and development account in the state economic development in-~~
41 ~~itiatives fund. All moneys credited to the Kansas economic development~~
42 ~~research and development account shall be used to promote, encourage~~
43 ~~and implement research and development programs and activities in Kan-~~

1 ~~sas and technical assistance funded through state educational institutions~~
2 ~~under the supervision and control of the state board of regents or other~~
3 ~~Kansas colleges and universities.~~
4 ~~—(d) There is hereby created the Kansas economic development en-~~
5 ~~dowment account in the state economic development initiatives fund. All~~
6 ~~moneys credited to the Kansas economic development endowment ac-~~
7 ~~count shall be accumulated and invested as provided in this section to~~
8 ~~provide an ongoing source of funds which shall be used for economic~~
9 ~~development activities in Kansas, including but not limited to continuing~~
10 ~~appropriations or demand transfers for programs and projects which shall~~
11 ~~include, but are not limited to, specific community infrastructure projects~~
12 ~~in Kansas that stimulate economic growth.~~
13 ~~—(e) Except as provided in subsection (f), the director of investments~~
14 ~~may invest and reinvest moneys credited to the state economic develop-~~
15 ~~ment initiatives fund in accordance with investment policies established~~
16 ~~by the pooled money investment board under K.S.A. 75-4232, and~~
17 ~~amendments thereto, in the pooled money investment portfolio. All mon-~~
18 ~~eys received as interest earned by the investment of the moneys credited~~
19 ~~to the state economic development initiatives fund shall be deposited in~~
20 ~~the state treasury and credited to the Kansas economic development en-~~
21 ~~dowment account of such fund.~~
22 ~~—(f) Moneys credited to the Kansas economic development endow-~~
23 ~~ment account of the state economic development initiatives fund may be~~
24 ~~invested in government guaranteed loans and debentures as provided by~~
25 ~~law in addition to the investments authorized by subsection (e) or in lieu~~
26 ~~of such investments. All moneys received as interest earned by the in-~~
27 ~~vestment under this subsection of the moneys credited to the Kansas~~
28 ~~economic development endowment account shall be deposited in the~~
29 ~~state treasury and credited to the Kansas economic development endow-~~
30 ~~ment account of the state economic development initiatives fund.~~
31 ~~—(g) In each fiscal year, the director of accounts and reports shall make~~
