

## SENATE BILL No. 599

9 AN ACT designating a portion of United States highway 69 as the Gor-  
10 don Parks memorial highway; amending K.S.A. 68-1038 and repealing  
11 the existing section.  
12

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 New Section 1. That portion of United States highway 69 from the  
15 northern boundary of Bourbon county then south to the southern bound-  
16 ary of Bourbon county is hereby designated the Gordon Parks memorial  
17 highway. The secretary of transportation shall place signs along the high-  
18 way right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the  
19 Gordon Parks memorial highway, except that such signs shall not be  
20 placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and  
21 donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs  
22 and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or  
23 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may ac-  
24 cept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing  
25 suitable signs.

26 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-1038 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-  
27 1038. From the junction of highway K-5 with United States highway 73  
28 and highway K-7, south on highway K-5 to the junction with Interstate  
29 highway 435, south on Interstate highway 435 to the junction with United  
30 States highway 69, south on United States highway 69 *to the northern*  
31 *boundary of Bourbon county, then south on United States highway 69*  
32 *from the southern boundary of Bourbon county* to the junction with  
33 United States highway 69 alternate, then south on United States highway  
34 69 alternate to the Kansas-Oklahoma line, such route is hereby designated  
35 as the Frontier Military scenic byway. The secretary of transportation shall  
36 place markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to in-  
37 dicate that the highway is the Frontier Military scenic byway. The sec-  
38 retary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to  
39 aid in obtaining and installing suitable highway signs.

40 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 68-1038 is hereby repealed.

41 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
42 publication in the statute book.
