

## House Concurrent Resolution No. 5029

9 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging Congress and the President  
10 of the United States to develop a program of capturing and storing  
11 carbon and other greenhouse gases.

13 WHEREAS, Kansans are concerned about global air pollution and are  
14 taking steps to reduce contribution to such pollution; and

15 WHEREAS, Energy and health care costs may significantly increase  
16 because of growth in carbon dioxide emissions from all sources; and

17 WHEREAS, No state's actions can singularly nor significantly address  
18 the risk to global air quality, energy costs and health care costs: Now,  
19 therefore,

20 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas,*  
21 *the Senate concurring therein:* That the President of the United States  
22 and Congress are strongly urged to engage in meaningful discourse based  
23 on sound science to develop a program of capturing and storing or se-  
24 questrating carbon and other greenhouse gases, particulates and heavy  
25 metals that cannot be productively used in other manufacturing proc-  
26 esses; and

27 *Be it further resolved:* That the President and Congress are urged to  
28 engage other nations in identifying cost-effective steps to reduce emis-  
29 sions on a global basis; and

30 *Be it further resolved:* That the secretary of state is directed to send  
31 enrolled copies of this resolution to the President of the United States,  
32 the Secretary of the United States Department of Energy and each mem-  
33 ber of the Kansas Congressional Delegation.
