9 AN ACT concerning utilities; relating to base load projections and energy
10 efficiency and load management programs.

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12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) The state corporation commission shall biennially pre-
14 pare and update an electric generation table report containing informa-
15 tion on the current and forecasted capacity and peak load for electric
16 public utilities operating in Kansas. The report shall be modeled after the
17 report published by the Kansas energy council on November 24, 2008,
18 and shall show projections for 5, 10 and 20 years from the current year.
19 The report shall be current through September 1 of the previous year.

20 (b) The commission shall submit a biennial written report to the gov-
21 ernor, to the house committee on energy and utilities and the senate
22 committee on utilities, or successors, on or before the first day of the
23 2010 regular session of the legislature and on or before the first day of
24 each regular session of the legislature every two years thereafter. The
25 commission shall also make the report available electronically and on its
26 internet website.

27 Sec. 2. Any electric public utility, as defined in K.S.A. 66-101a, and
28 amendments thereto, shall develop and implement not later than Decem-
29 ber 1, 2010, an enhanced energy efficiency and load management pro-
30 gram which shall provide information, technical assistance and incentives
31 to each type of customer and customer class, the annual cumulative effect
32 of which shall have the potential to reduce such utility's total power gen-
33 eration requirements. To achieve the reduction, each utility shall consider
34 the PAYS program authorized by the provisions of K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 66-
35 1248, and amendments thereto, as well as other energy education and
36 conservation promotion programs that are consistent with any goals which
37 may be developed by the Kansas energy office of the state corporation
38 commission. On or before July 1, 2011, each utility shall submit to the
39 state corporation commission a report setting forth the elements of the
40 utility's enhanced energy efficiency and load management programs.

41 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
42 publication in the statute book.
