10 AN ACT concerning the disposition of district court fines, penalties and
11 forfeitures; relating to the percentage credited to the department of
12 corrections alcohol and drug abuse treatment program; amending
13 K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 74-7336 and repealing the existing section.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

16 Section 1. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby amended to read as
17 follows: 74-7336. (a) Of the remittances of fines, penalties and forfeitures
18 received from clerks of the district court, at least monthly, the state trea-
19 surer shall credit:

- 20 (1) 11.99% to the crime victims compensation fund;
21 (2) 2.45% to the crime victims assistance fund;
22 (3) 3.01% to the community alcoholism and intoxication programs
23 fund;
24 (4) ~~2.01%~~ ~~6.3%~~ **7.01%** to the department of corrections alcohol and
25 drug abuse treatment fund;
26 (5) 0.17% to the boating fee fund;
27 (6) 0.12% to the children's advocacy center fund;
28 (7) 2.50% to the EMS revolving fund; **and**
29 ~~(8) 2.50% to the trauma fund;~~
30 ~~(9) 2.50% to the traffic records enhancement fund; and~~
31 ~~(10)~~ **(8)** the remainder of the remittances to the state general fund.

32 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit grant moneys as provided in
33 subsection (a), from the crime victims assistance fund, to the credit of a
34 special fund created for use by the county or district attorney in estab-
35 lishing and maintaining programs to aid witnesses and victims of crime.

36 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby repealed.
