10 conduct giving rise to forfeiture; amending K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 60-4104
11 and repealing the existing section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 60-4104 is hereby amended to read as
15 follows: 60-4104. Conduct and offenses giving rise to forfeiture under this
16 act, whether or not there is a prosecution or conviction related to the
17 offense, are:

- 18 (a) All offenses which statutorily and specifically authorize forfeiture;
19 (b) violations of the uniform controlled substances act, K.S.A. 65-
20 4101 et seq., and amendments thereto;
21 (c) theft which is classified as a felony violation pursuant to K.S.A.
22 21-3701, and amendments thereto, in which the property taken was
23 livestock;
24 (d) unlawful discharge of a firearm, K.S.A. 21-4219, and amendments
25 thereto;
26 (e) money laundering, K.S.A. 65-4142, and amendments thereto;
27 (f) gambling, K.S.A. 21-4303, and amendments thereto, and com-
28 mercial gambling, K.S.A. 21-4304, and amendments thereto;
29 (g) counterfeiting, K.S.A. 21-3763, and amendments thereto;
30 (h) violations of K.S.A. 21-4019, and amendments thereto;
31 (i) medicaid fraud, K.S.A. 21-3844 et seq., and amendments thereto;
32 (j) an act or omission occurring outside this state, which would be a
33 violation in the place of occurrence and would be described in this section
34 if the act occurred in this state, whether or not it is prosecuted in any
35 state;
36 (k) an act or omission committed in furtherance of any act or omission
37 described in this section including any inchoate or preparatory offense,
38 whether or not there is a prosecution or conviction related to the act or
39 omission;
40 (l) any solicitation or conspiracy to commit any act or omission de-
41 scribed in this section, whether or not there is a prosecution or conviction
42 related to the act or omission;
43 (m) furtherance of terrorism or illegal use of weapons of mass de-

1 struction, K.S.A. 21-3451, and amendments thereto;
2 (n) *prostitution, K.S.A. 21-3512, and amendments thereto, promoting*
3 *prostitution, K.S.A. 21-3513, and amendments thereto, and patronizing a*
4 *prostitute, K.S.A. 21-3515, and amendments thereto.*
5 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 60-4104 is hereby repealed.
6 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
7 publication in the statute book.
