## **HOUSE BILL No. 2273**

AN ACT concerning state agencies; providing for the development and implementation of a zero-based budget process.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The director of the budget shall develop and implement a zero-based budget process under which each state agency shall submit a zero-based budget estimate for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, except that each state agency that is required by K.S.A. 75-3717, and amendments thereto, to submit budget estimates on a biennial basis shall submit zero-based budget estimates for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2012, and June 30, 2013. The zero-based budget process shall be applied on a six-year cycle commencing with budget estimates submitted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012.

- (b) The zero-based budget estimates created pursuant to the zero-based budget process established under this section shall contain information fulfilling all of the following criteria:
- (1) A description of each activity performed for which an appropriation is made or requested;
  - (2) the legal basis for performing the activity; and
- (3) an itemized justification for the amount requested to perform the activity.
- (c) The director of the budget shall evaluate the zero-based budget process on a continuing basis and shall report to the legislative budget committee, on or before December 31, 2012, and on or before each December 31 every six years thereafter, regarding whether the zero-based budget process for state agencies has resulted in an increased cost-effective delivery of public services.
- (d) As used in this section, "zero-based budget" means determining a budget by starting with a base of zero dollars and adding dollar amounts necessary to conduct specific activities and operations, and "state agency" has the meaning ascribed thereto by K.S.A. 75-3701, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
