AN ACT concerning the department of health and environment; establishing the health and environment training fee fund — health, the health and environment training fee fund — environment and the nuclear safety emergency preparedness special revenue fund; authorizing certain fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The secretary of health and environment is hereby authorized to fix, charge and collect fees in order to recover all or part of the costs attributable to acquisition and distribution of literature and audio-visual materials and for participation in or conducting training seminars for training employees of the division of health of the department of health and environment, for training recipients of state aid from the division of health of the department of health and environment, and for training representatives of industries affected by rules and regulations of the department of health and environment relating to the division of health.

(b) There is hereby established the health and environment training fee fund — health which shall be administered by the secretary of health and environment. All moneys received from the fees under this section shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the health and environment training fee fund — health. In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the division of the department of health from moneys appropriated from the fund, expenditures may be made from the fund for agency operations for the division of health.

Sec. 2. (a) The secretary of health and environment is hereby authorized to fix, charge and collect fees in order to recover all or part of the costs attributable to acquisition and distribution of literature and audio-visual materials and for participation in or conducting training seminars for training employees of the division of environment of the department of health and environment, for training recipients of state aid from the division of environment of the department of health and environment, and for training representatives of industries affected by rules and regu-

lations of the department of health and environment relating to the division of environment.

- (b) There is hereby established the health and environment training fee fund— environment which shall be administered by the secretary of health and environment. All moneys received from the fees shall be deposited in the state treasury in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto, and shall be credited to the health and environment training fee fund environment. In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the division of the department of health from moneys appropriated from the fund, expenditures may be made from the fund for agency operations for the division of environment.
- Sec. 3. There is hereby established the nuclear safety emergency preparedness special revenue fund in the state treasury which shall be administered by the secretary of health and environment for the division of environment of the department of health and environment. Except as otherwise provided by appropriation acts, all moneys received by the secretary of health and environment from the nuclear safety emergency management fee fund of the adjutant general shall be credited to the nuclear safety emergency preparedness special revenue fund of the department of health and environment division of environment and shall be expended for the purposes for which such moneys were provided by the adjutant general. All expenditures from the nuclear safety emergency preparedness special revenue fund shall be in accordance with the provisions of appropriation acts upon vouchers approved by the secretary of health and environment or a person or persons authorized by the secretary.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
