9 AN ACT concerning the personal and family protection act; amending
10 K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 75-7c10 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 75-7c10 is hereby amended to read as
14 follows: 75-7c10. (a) Provided that the premises are conspicuously posted
15 in accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the attorney general
16 as premises where carrying a concealed weapon is prohibited, no license
17 issued pursuant to this act shall authorize the licensee to carry a concealed
18 weapon into:

19 (1) Any place where an activity declared a common nuisance by
20 K.S.A. 22-3901, and amendments thereto, is maintained;

21 (2) any police, sheriff or highway patrol station;

22 (3) any detention facility, prison or jail;

23 (4) any courthouse;

24 (5) any courtroom, except that nothing in this section would preclude
25 a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or determining who will carry
26 a concealed weapon in the judge's courtroom;

27 (6) any polling place on the day an election is held;

28 (7) any meeting of the governing body of a county, city or other po-
29 litical or taxing subdivision of the state, or any committee or subcommit-
30 tee thereof;

31 (8) on the state fairgrounds;

32 (9) any state office building;

33 (10) any athletic event not related to or involving firearms which is
34 sponsored by a private or public elementary or secondary school or any
35 private or public institution of postsecondary education;

36 (11) any professional athletic event not related to or involving
37 firearms;

38 (12) any portion of a drinking establishment as defined by K.S.A. 41-
39 2601, and amendments thereto, except that this provision shall not apply
40 to a restaurant as defined by K.S.A. 41-2601, and amendments thereto;

41 (13) any elementary or secondary school, attendance center, admin-
42 istrative office, services center or other facility;

43 (14) any community college, college or university facility;

- 1 (15) any place where the carrying of firearms is prohibited by federal
2 or state law;
- 3 (16) any child exchange and visitation center provided for in K.S.A.
4 75-720, and amendments thereto;
- 5 (17) any community mental health center organized pursuant to
6 K.S.A. 19-4001 et seq., and amendments thereto; mental health clinic
7 organized pursuant to K.S.A. 65-211 et seq., and amendments thereto;
8 psychiatric hospital licensed under K.S.A. 75-3307b, and amendments
9 thereto; or state psychiatric hospital, as follows: Larned state hospital,
10 Osawatomie state hospital or Rainbow mental health facility;
- 11 (18) any city hall;
- 12 (19) any public library operated by the state or by a political subdi-
13 vision of the state;
- 14 (20) any day care home or group day care home, as defined in Kansas
15 administrative regulation 28-4-113, or any preschool or childcare center,
16 as defined in Kansas administrative regulation 28-4-420;
- 17 (21) any church or temple; or
- 18 (22) any place in violation of K.S.A. 21-4218, and amendments
19 thereto.
- 20 *(b) A person who is otherwise qualified to carry a concealed weapon*
21 *may carry such weapon into any church or temple even if such premises*
22 *are posted if the person has the written permission of the pastor or other*
23 *person in charge of such church or temple to carry a concealed weapon.*
- 24 ~~(b)~~ (c) Violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.
- 25 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 75-7c10 is hereby repealed.
- 26 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
27 publication in the statute book.
