

## House Concurrent Resolution No. 5017

9 A PROPOSITION to amend section 4 of the bill of rights of the consti-  
10 tution of the state of Kansas, relating to the right to bear arms.

12 *Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, two-thirds of the*  
13 *members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Repre-*  
14 *sentatives and two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and*  
15 *qualified to the Senate concurring therein:*

16 Section 1. The following proposition to amend the constitution of the  
17 state of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state  
18 for their approval or rejection: Section 4 of the bill of rights of the con-  
19 stitution of the state of Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

20 “§ 4 *Individual right to bear arms; armies. The people have*  
21 ~~*the right to bear arms for their defense and security. A person has*~~  
22 *the right to keep and bear arms for the defense of self, family, home*  
23 *and state, for lawful hunting and recreational use, and for any other*  
24 *lawful purpose; but standing armies, in time of peace, are dangerous*  
25 *to liberty, and shall not be tolerated, and the military shall be in*  
26 *strict subordination to the civil power.”*

27 Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with  
28 the amendment as a whole:

29 “*Explanatory statement.* The purpose of this amendment is to pre-  
30 serve constitutionally the right of a person to keep and bear arms  
31 for the defense of self, family, home and state, and for all other  
32 lawful purposes, including hunting and recreation.

33 “A vote for this amendment would constitutionally preserve the  
34 right of a person to keep and bear arms for the defense of self,  
35 family, home and state, and for lawful hunting and recreational  
36 use, and for any other lawful purpose.

37 “A vote against this amendment would provide for no constitutional  
38 right of a person to keep and bear arms for the defense of self,  
39 family, home and state, and for lawful hunting and recreational  
40 use, and for any other lawful purpose.”

41 Sec. 3. This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members  
42 elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of Representatives, and  
43 two-thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the

1 Senate shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas and nays.  
2 The secretary of state shall cause this resolution to be published as pro-  
3 vided by law and shall cause the proposed amendment to be submitted  
4 to the electors of the state at the general election in the year 2010 unless  
5 a special election is called at a sooner date by concurrent resolution of  
6 the legislature, in which case it shall be submitted to the electors of the  
7 state at the special election.
