9 AN ACT concerning tanning facilities; regulating minors' use of tanning  
10 device.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) No tanning facility shall allow any person under 14  
14 years of age to use a tanning device.

15 (b) No tanning facility shall allow any person 14 years of age or older  
16 but under 18 years of age to use a tanning device unless the minor's parent  
17 or court-appointed legal guardian provides a written consent to an owner  
18 of the tanning facility or an operator responsible for the operation of the  
19 ultraviolet radiation device of the facility.

20 (c) The board of cosmetology shall prescribe the consent form which  
21 shall include:

22 (1) A statement that the minor's parent or legal guardian has read  
23 and understood the warnings provided by the tanning facility and con-  
24 sented to the minor's use of protective eyewear and suitable physical  
25 aides; and

26 (2) proof of the minor's age in a form prescribed by the board through  
27 rules and regulations. The minor's parent or legal guardian may withdraw  
28 the consent at any time. Unless so withdrawn, the consent shall be valid  
29 for 12 months from the date when the consent is signed and may be  
30 renewed annually in accordance with this section.

31 (d) The written consent and a copy of the letters of guardianship, if  
32 such consent is given by a guardian, shall be retained by the tanning  
33 facility for a period of five years.

34 (e) The board of cosmetology shall adopt such rules and regulations  
35 as are necessary to effectuate the provisions of this section.

36 (f) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the tanning fa-  
37 cilities act of the state of Kansas.

38 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 65-1920 through 65-1929 and section 1, and amend-  
39 ments thereto, shall be known and may be cited as the tanning facilities  
40 act.

41 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
42 publication in the statute book.
