10 AN ACT concerning the emergency medical services board; authorizing  
11 the assessment of civil penalties.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. The emergency medical services board, in ~~addition to~~ **lieu**  
15 **of** any other penalty prescribed by law, may assess a civil fine, after proper  
16 notice and an opportunity to be heard, against any person granted a li-  
17 cense, certificate of qualification or authorization to practice by the board  
18 for a violation of a law or rule and regulation applicable to the practice  
19 for which such person has been granted a license, certificate of qualifi-  
20 cation or authorization by the board in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.  
21 All fines assessed and collected under this section shall be remitted to  
22 the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215,  
23 and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state  
24 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit  
25 of the state general fund.

26 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
27 publication in the statute book.
