9 AN ACT concerning cities; relating to publication of ordinances; amend-  
10 ing K.S.A. 12-3007 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 12-3007 is hereby amended to read as follows: 12-  
14 3007. The city clerk shall cause all ordinances, except appropriation or-  
15 dinances, as soon as practicable after they have been passed and signed,  
16 passed over the mayor's veto or will take effect without signature, to be  
17 published once in the official city newspaper, unless a statute requires  
18 more publications. Ordinances shall take effect the day of publication  
19 unless a different and later day is stated in the ordinance or otherwise  
20 specified by statute: *Provided*, That appropriation ordinances shall take  
21 effect upon passage. The publisher shall print in a line preceding the  
22 number of the ordinance a statement in parentheses as follows: (Pub-  
23 lished \_\_\_\_\_, 19\_\_\_\_), giving the month, day and year. The manner of  
24 publication and effective date of codifications shall be as hereinafter  
25 provided.

26 *In lieu of full publication of an ordinance pursuant to this section, a*  
27 *city may publish a summary of the ordinance so long as: (1) The publi-*  
28 *cation contains notice that the complete text of the ordinance may be*  
29 *obtained or viewed at the office of the city clerk; and (2) the city attorney*  
30 *reviews the summary of the ordinance prior to its publication to ensure*  
31 *that the summary is legally accurate and sufficient.*

32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 12-3007 is hereby repealed.

33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
34 publication in the statute book.
