9 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school finance; amend-  
10 ing K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 72-64c04 and repealing the existing section.

12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 72-64c04 is hereby amended to read  
14 as follows: 72-64c04. (a) For school year 2007-2008, and for each school  
15 year thereafter years 2009-2010, 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013,  
16 the total amount of state aid, except for state aid for special education  
17 and related services, shall be increased by not less than a percentage equal  
18 to the percentage increase in the CPI (urban) during the preceding fiscal  
19 year as certified to the commissioner of education by the director of the  
20 budget and the director of the legislative research department on August  
21 15 of each year. Such state aid shall be distributed and adjusted for  
22 weighted enrollment changes in the manner provided by law. If there is  
23 a percentage decrease or no change in the CPI (urban) during the pre-  
24 ceding fiscal year, the amount of state aid, excluding state aid for special  
25 education and related services, shall be no less than the amount of such  
26 aid in the preceding fiscal year.

27 ~~(b) The increases in the amount of state aid attributable to the new~~  
28 ~~weightings created by this act, the increases in the existing weightings~~  
29 ~~and the increases in the amount of base state aid per pupil shall be~~  
30 ~~deemed to satisfy the requirements of subsection (a) for school years~~  
31 ~~2007-2008 and 2008-2009.~~

32 ~~(c) The provisions of this section shall expire on June 30, 2010.~~

33 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 72-64c04 is hereby repealed.
