12 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; providing for a Boy Scouts of Amer-
13 ica license plate.

15 WHEREAS, In light of the Boy Scouts of America celebrating its
16 100th anniversary, on February 8, 2010, and the tremendously positive
17 impact scouting has made on America's youth: Now, therefore, *Be it en-*
18 *acted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

19 Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2011, any owner or lessee of
20 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of
21 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance with
22 the provisions of this section, may be issued one Boy Scouts of America
23 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. In addition to the
24 license plate, a person issued such a license plate may request a decal for
25 the order of the arrow, wood badge, God and county award and eagle
26 scout for each license plate. Such license plates shall be issued for the
27 same time as other license plates upon proper registration and payment
28 of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments
29 thereto, and the presentation of the annual logo use authorization state-
30 ment provided for in subsection (b).

31 (b) A Boy Scouts of America council may authorize the use of their
32 logo to be affixed on license plates or any decal as provided by this section.
33 Any royalty payment received pursuant to this section shall be paid to the
34 Boy Scouts of America and shall be used to support the Boy Scouts of
35 America. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee annually may apply to the
36 Boy Scouts of America for the use of such logo. Upon annual application
37 and payment to the Boy Scouts of America in an amount of not less than
38 \$25 nor more than \$100 as a logo use royalty payment for each license
39 plate and decal to be issued, the Boy Scouts of America shall issue to the
40 motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use au-
41 thorization statement, which shall be presented by the motor vehicle
42 owner or lessee at the time of registration.

43 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may

1 make application for such plates not less than 60 days prior to such per-
2 son's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by
3 the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plates shall
4 provide the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in sub-
5 section (b). Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck
6 and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the
7 owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon
8 forms furnished by the director.

9 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be
10 transferable to any other person.

11 (e) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made an-
12 nually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in subsection (a), in the man-
13 ner prescribed in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments
14 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until
15 such applicant provides the annual logo use authorization statement pro-
16 vided for in subsection (b). If such logo use authorization statement is
17 not presented at the time of registration, the applicant shall be required
18 to comply with K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the
19 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

20 (f) The Boy Scouts of America councils shall:

21 (1) Pay the initial cost of silk-screening for license plates authorized
22 by this section; and

23 (2) provide to all county treasurers a toll-free telephone number
24 where applicants can call the Boy Scouts of America councils for infor-
25 mation concerning the application process or the status of their license
26 plate application.

27 (g) The Boy Scouts of America councils, with the approval of the
28 director of vehicles and subject to the availability of materials and equip-
29 ment, shall design a plate and decals to be issued under the provisions of
30 this section.

31 (h) A fee of \$2 shall be paid for each decal issued under this section.
32 Such decals shall be affixed to the license plate in the location required
33 by the director.

34 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
35 publication in the statute book.
