9 AN ACT concerning the liquor enforcement tax; relating to violations of  
10 such law; prescribing penalties therefor; licensees and persons re-  
11 quired to be licensed.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. (a) The director of taxation or the director of alcoholic  
15 beverage control may enjoin any person from engaging in business in  
16 which such person is required to be licensed by the director of alcoholic  
17 beverage control when the person is in violation of any of the provisions  
18 of K.S.A. 79-4101 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any of the terms  
19 of this act, and shall be entitled in any proceeding brought for that pur-  
20 pose to have an order restraining the person from engaging in such busi-  
21 ness. No bond shall be required for any such restraining order or for any  
22 temporary or permanent injunction issued in that proceeding.

23 (b) If any licensee licensed by the director of alcoholic beverage con-  
24 trol violates any of the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4101 et seq., and amend-  
25 ments thereto, or any of the terms of this act, the director of alcoholic  
26 beverage control may suspend or revoke the license of such licensee in  
27 accordance with K.S.A. 41-320, and amendments thereto, or may impose  
28 a civil fine on the licensee in the manner provided by K.S.A. 41-328, and  
29 amendments thereto, or both.

30 (c) The provisions of this section shall be part of and supplemental  
31 to the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4101 et seq., and amendments thereto.

32 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
33 publication in the statute book.
