10 AN ACT concerning motor vehicle registrations; relating to insufficient
11 payment to county treasurers; amending K.S.A. 8-145b and repealing
12 the existing section.

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. K.S.A. 8-145b is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-
16 145b. (a) If the full amount of the license fee for which an insufficient or
17 no-fund check was given, a credit **[or debit]** card payment that is sub-
18 sequently rejected or reversed by the credit **[or debit]** card issuer or a
19 payment instrument drawn on or issued by a bank or other financial
20 institution is not received in the office of the county treasurer, after the
21 giving of notice, within the time hereinbefore prescribed, the county trea-
22 surer shall certify to the sheriff of the county, the name and address of
23 the person uttering such insufficient or no-fund check, *rejected or re-*
24 *versed credit **[or debit]** card payment or payment instrument drawn on*
25 *or issued by a bank or other financial institution* together with the reg-
26 istration number and a description of the vehicle registered and it shall
27 be the duty of the sheriff to recover the registration number plate for
28 which such check, *credit **[or debit]** card payment or payment instrument*
29 ~~was uttered. *Provided,*~~ Nothing in this act is to be construed to exclude
30 criminal prosecutions as in other cases involving insufficient or no-fund
31 checks.

32 (b) *For the purposes of this section, "payment instrument" shall have*
33 *the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 9-508 and amendments thereto.*

34 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-145b is hereby repealed.

35 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
36 publication in the statute book.
