9 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to medicaid replacement
10 state aid; amending K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 72-998 and repealing the ex-
11 isting section.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 72-998 is hereby amended to read as
15 follows: 72-998. (a) As used in this section:

16 (1) "Medicaid children" means exceptional children who receive spe-
17 cial education and related services and for which the district receives
18 medicaid payments.

19 (2) Words and phrases used in this section, have the meanings as-
20 cribed thereto in K.S.A. 72-962, and amendments thereto.

21 (b) ~~The provisions of this section shall be applicable for school years~~
22 ~~2007-2008, 2008-2009 and 2009-2010.~~ The state board shall designate a
23 portion of the amount of moneys appropriated as special education serv-
24 ices state aid as medicaid replacement state aid. The amount designated
25 by the state board shall not exceed \$9,000,000 in any school year.

26 (c) Subject to the limitations of this section and appropriations there-
27 for, each school district shall be entitled to medicaid replacement state
28 aid. The amount of such state aid shall be computed by the state board
29 as provided in this section. The state board shall:

30 (1) Determine the total number of medicaid children in all school
31 districts on March 1 of each school year;

32 (2) divide the amount of moneys designated as medicaid replacement
33 state aid by the amount determined under paragraph (1); and

34 (3) multiply the quotient determined under paragraph (2) by the
35 number of medicaid children in each school district on March 1 of each
36 school year. The product is the amount of medicaid replacement state
37 aid the district is entitled to receive.

38 (d) All amounts received by a school district under this section shall
39 be deposited in the general fund of the district and shall be transferred
40 to the special education fund of the district.

41 (e) The board of education of any district desiring to receive state aid
42 pursuant to this section shall submit any documentation or information
43 to the state board as it may request. The state board may establish dead-

1 lines for the submission of such documentation and information.

2 (f) The state board shall make the distribution of moneys under this
3 section prior to determining the amount of state aid to be distributed
4 under K.S.A. 72-978, and amendments thereto.

5 (g) The state board shall prescribe all forms necessary for reporting
6 under this section.

7 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 72-998 is hereby repealed.

8 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
9 publication in the statute book.
