HB 2647, An act relating to public finance; creating the Kansas taxpayer transparency act; defining terms; requiring the secretary of administration to develop and operate a specified website; enumerating information which shall be made available on such website; establishing a time period covered for information on such website; establishing the public finance transparency board and prescribing its duties; and providing for nondisclosure of certain information, by Committee on Government Efficiency and Technology.
