MINUTES OF MEETING

STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

January 24, 1961

State Affairs Committee met in room 522, at 1:30 P.M. Chairman Taylor called the meeting to order and introduced Mr. Glad to explain the intent and purpose of House Bill No. 5.

After discussion, it was moved by Mr. Ford, seconded by Mr. Bisbee and unanimously carried, that in line 6 of Section I, the word "Hereford" be stricken and in lieu thereof the word "livestock" be inserted; and that the Committee recommend the passage of the bill as amended.

House Bill No. 21 was again discussed, and a clarifying statement made by the Chairman. Whereupon it was moved by Mr. Fribley, seconded by Mr. Johnson, and unanimously passed, that the Committee recommend the passage of same.

The Chairman discussed the receipt of proposed legislation from the Legislative Council, and the rules governing same. A proposed measure which had been submitted to the Committee from the Legislative Council was discussed. It was moved by Mr. Fribley, seconded by Mr. Ford and unanimously passed that the bill be introduced by the Committee, and then re-referred to the Committee for further consideration.

It was moved by Mr. Fribley, seconded by Mr. Ford and unanimously passed, that the meeting be adjourned.
