Senator Smith presented a bill to release some fee funds for use during the second semester at Kansas State University, Manhattan, Kansas State Teachers College, Emporia, and Kansas University at Lawrence. This release is necessary because the increase in enrollment at these three schools exceeded the estimate made when the original budget was made up for the fiscal year 1961. These funds are to be used primarily for salaries for additional faculty members for the second semester.

Senator Smith moved that this bill be introduced, and Senator Farmer seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The committee voted to take a tour of the four divisions of the Department of Administration to become familiar with that department.
