## Minutes of Meeting March 23, 1961

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by the Chairman, Senator Lauterbach, with all members present except Senator Hults.

Senator Sanborn moved that House Bill #439 be recommended for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Smith. Senator Warren made a substitute motion that the appropriation for renovating Cedar Crest for a governor's mansion be deleted from the bill. Motion failed because there was no second. Original motion carried.

Senator Sanborn moved that House Bill #440 be recommended for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Warren. Motion carried.

Senator Smith presented a bill which would cause the educational institutions to follow the same procedure for budgeting their long range building program in the same way their operating programs are budgeted. Senator Farmer made a motion that the bill be amended before being introduced, seconded by Senator Glades. Motion carried. Senator Smith moved that this bill be introduced, as amended, as a committee bill. Motion seconded by Senator VanSickle. Motion carried. (SB #401).

Senator Farmer moved that when SJR #2 is referred to this committee, it should be recommended for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Doty. Motion carried.
