WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of Meeting April 5, 1961

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. by the Vice-Chairman, Senator Smith, with all members present except Senator Lauterbach.

Senator Sanborn moved that House Bill #478 should be recommended for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Glades. Motion carried.

Senator Ward moved to amend House Bill #1,80 by adding \$4,50 to the Administrative Expense Item for the Industrial Development Commission, and also, amend the total. Motion seconded by Senator Doty, carried.

Senator Warren moved to amend House Bill #480 by the addition of \$6,000 for payment of educational costs to the Wilroads Gardens Schools which educates children of the members and employees residing at Fort Dodge. This amount was deleted by the House Committee on Ways and Means. Motion seconded by Senator Glades. Motion carried.

Senator Glades moved to recommend House Bill #480 for passage as amended. Motion seconded by Senator Warren. Motion carried.

Senator Glades moved that House Bill #482 be recommended for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Ward. Motion carried.

Senator Sanborn moved that House Bill #483 be recommended for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Doty. Motion carried.

Senator Hultsmoved to recommend House Bill #484 for passage. Motion seconded by Senator Harper. Motion carried.

Senator Hults moved that House Bill #485 be amended by removing two items for street paving, one in the Kansas Neurological Institute budget, and the other in theTopeka State Hospital budget, and that the totals be changed. These two items are to be included in the Omnibus bill, and be paid out of General Revenue Funds, rather than out of institutional building funds. Motion seconded by Senator Warren. Motion carried.

Senator Hults moved that House Bill #485 be recommended for passage as amended. Motion seconded by Senator Sanborn, carried.
