Minutes of the Meeting January 22, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 9:15 a.m. on January 22, 1962. All the members were present except Senators Doty and Hults.

It was brought to the attention of the committee by James Bibb of the Budget Division that the Governor is requesting that the positions deleted by the committee in the budget of the Reception and Diagnostic Center be restored. It was decided by the committee to ask to have this bill rereferred to the committee for further study.

Senator Smith reported to the committee that Ward Martin who is a member of the Regents for Washburn Municipal University has extended to the committee an invitation for lunch at Washburn and further that the committee should select the day for this luncheon. It was decided to tentatively set Thursday, February 1, as the date for this luncheon.

Senator Warren made a motion, seconded by Senator Harper, that House Bill No. 1 be referred back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be passed. The motion carried.

Senator Glades made a motion, seconded by Senator Warren, that the subcommittee's reports for the State Department of Public Instruction and the Board of Vocational Education be approved and a bill be drafted. The motion

Senator Glades made a motion, seconded by Senator Warren, that a letter be drafted to the Board of Vocational Education notifying them that it is the intention of the committee to allow the three positions for the on-the-job training program but that no appropriation would be made for these positions. The Chairman then instructed Senators Glades and Warren to draft the letter.

Mr. Chairman:

Your subcommittee assigned to the State Department of Public Instruction recommends that the budget of this agency be approved as recommended by the Governor with the following exception:

- a. Eliminate position of Transportation Consultant. This position was defeated in the last general session, and it is thought to be unwise to create a new division within a department during a budget session.
- b. The Superintendent of Public Instruction agreed with the subcommittee to start charging for certain publications that have previously been given away.
