SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting February 1, 1962

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Lauterbach at 3:30 p.m. on February 1, 1962. All the members were present except Senator Van Sickle.

Senator Doty made a motion, seconded by Senator Hults, that House Bill No. 37 be recommended for passage. The motion earried.

Representative Roy Taylor appeared before the committee on behalf of House Bill No. 23. He explained to the committee the historical features of a park which would be created upon the passage of this bill.

Representative John Conard and Senetor Paul Wunsch appeared before the committee on behalf of House Bill No. 33. An explanation was given for the reason for the provise which sets the salary of Frederic H. Guild and further provides that he may be employed for the next fiscal year. Dr. Guild would be retired at the close of this fiscal year unless this provise is included in this manner.

Senator Doty made a motion, seconded by Senator Ward, that House Bill No. 23 be tabled. The motion carried.

Senator Hults made a motion, seconded by Senator Sanborn, that House Bill No. 33 be recommended for passage. Senator Harper made a substitute motion to strike the four lines in Sec. 2 beginning with "Salary of" and ending with the figure "15,000". There was no second to this substitute motion. The motion of Senator Hults carried.

The meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
