Minutes

The eleventh meeting of the Education Committee convened at 3:15 P.M., Wednesday afternoon, February 13, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present except Mr. Dreiling; Mr. Finney had been previously excused.

It was their conclusion that the proposed bill's delegation of authority to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction is satisfactory and could not be changed without disturbing its constitutionality.
