### HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

### EDUCATION COMMITTEE

#### Minutes

The thirty-first meeting of the Education Committee convened at 3:00 P.M., March 25, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding.

All the members were present except Messrs. Dreiling, and Teter. Mr. Nesmith had been previously excused.

## SENATE BILL NO. 10:

Senator Steadman Ball explained this bill for the Committee relating the history of like previous bills that had failed to pass the Legislature and the need for such a scholarship plan.

The Chair introduced Miss Mary Showengerdt who in turn introduced President Stroll from Baker University, Dr. Martin of Ottawa University and Father Hammond of St. Benedict, each of whom spoke to the Committee in favor of the bill.

After a lengthy discussion with the guest and other Committee discussion, the motion was made by Mr. Finney, seconded by Mr. Hughes, that Senate Bill No. 10 be amended in Section 2, Line 3, after the word "superintendent" by adding "or any school or college under the jurisdiction of the State Board of Regents." The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Tillotson made the motion, seconded by Mr. Lill, that the Committee recommend Senate Bill No. 10 as amended favorably for passage. The motion carried with a vote of eleven for the Bill and two against.

# SENATE BILL NO. 432:

After a discussion of this bill, Mr. Casado made the motion, seconded by Mr. Robinson, that Senate Bill No. 432 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried unanimously.
