## EDUCATION COMMITTEE

## Minutes

The thirty-seventh meeting of the Education Committee convened at 5:25 P.M., April 3, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present.

Representative Henry Watkins presented a bill to increase levy limits for schools in Neosho County.

Mr. Dixon made the motion, seconded by Mr. Smith, that the Committee introduce it as an Education Committee bill, and recommend it for passage. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Boyd presented two bills which he asked the Committee to introduce which would repeal the Wichita University bills.

The motion was made by Mr. Vogel, seconded by Mr. Tillotson, that the introduction of these bills be voted on by secret ballot. The motion carried by a vote of ten for and six against.

Mr. Unruh and Mr. Dixon were appointed to count the ballots.

On the motion made by Mr. Boyd and seconded by Mr. Smith that the Committee introduce two bills to repeal the Wichita University bills, the motion carried by a vote of ten ballots for the introduction of the bills and nine against, with two ballots unmarked.

The meeting adjourned at 5:40 P.M.
