Minutes

The thirty-eighth meeting of the Education Committee convened at 4:45 P.M., Thursday afternoon, April 4, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present except Mr. Dreiling.

SENATE BILL No. 438:

Mr. Thaine D. McCormick, State Director of Vocational Education spoke to the Committee in explanation of this bill authorizing districts to combine to form area vocational-technical schools. He explained the need for this type of schooling in the State, the many ways it would function and the finances including State and Federal aid.

After a discussion of the bill, the motion was made by Mr. Tillotson, seconded by Mr. McCall, that Senate Bill No. 438 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried unanimously.

SENATE BILL No. 161:

After a discussion of the bill, Mr. Lill made the motion, seconded by Mr. Casado, that Senate Bill No. 161 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried by a vote of nine for and seven against.
