### HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

### EDUCATION COMMITTEE

#### Minutes

The thirty-ninth meeting of the Education Committee convened at 4:45 P.M., Monday afternoon, April 8, 1963 in Room 522 with Chairman Bower presiding. All the members were present except Mr. Vogel who had been previously excused.

## SENATE BILL No. 420:

Mr. Smith made the motion that Senate Bill No. 420 be amended to lower the amount \$5.00 in Line 6 of Section 2. The motion failed for want of a second.

The motion was made by Mr. Dixon, seconded by Mr. Crow, that Senate Bill No. 420 be recommended favorably for passage. The motion carried.

# SENATE BILL No. 435, tabled:

Mr. Tillotson made the motion, seconded by Mr. Finney, that State Bill No. 435 be tabled. The motion carried.

# SENATE BILL No. 443:

After a discussion of the bill, the motion was made by Mr. Casado, seconded by Mr. Finney, that the bill be amended in Section 6, subsection 3, to reduce the 50% figure to 30% for PL874 funds in grades one through twelve. It was pointed out that the wording in the new bill took care of this matter and the motion was withdrawn.

Mr. Lill made the motion, seconded by Mr. Casado, that Senate Bill No. 443 be recommended favorably for passage.

Mr. Smith made the motion, seconded by Mr. Boyd, that the Committee vote on this bill by secret ballot. The motion carried by a

vote of eleven for and seven against.

Mr. Dixon and Mr. Unruh were appointed by the Chair to count the ballots.

The motion to recommend Senate Bill No. 443 favorably failed by a vote of nine for passage and eleven against.

Upon motion of Mr. Tillotson, the meeting adjourned at 5:30 P.M.
