House Judiciary Committee Meeting Thursday, February 21, 1963

The House Judiciary Committee met Thursday, February 21, 1963, in Room 523 at 8:45 A.M. with Chairman Clyde Hill presiding. Eleven members were present. Members Arthur, Davis, Fatzer, Gardner, Gastl, Griffith, Smith, Van Cleave and Williams were absent.

Chairman Hill called the meeting to order.

The members of the committee discussed and decided to introduce a number of committee bills and have these bills referred back to the committee for further consideration. The bills to be introduced are as follows:

An act relating to probation and parole, prescribing the definition for the word "institution"; amending section 62-2227 of the General Statutes Supplement of 1961, and repealing said original section.

An act relating to crimes and punishment; requiring county attorneys to submit information, approved by sentencing judges, regarding convicted felons concerning the circumstances of the offense and the background of the offender.

An act relating to the Kansas bureau of investigation, describing the number of members thereof; amending section 75-711 of the General Statutes Supplement of 1961, and repealing said original section.

An act relating to professional service corporations as therein defined, authorizing the incorporation and organization thereof, providing special provisions, conditions and regulations, and prescribing certain powers, duties, liabilities and restrictions.

An act relating to county courts, and pertaining to the jurisdiction thereof; amending section 20-808 of the General Statutes of 1949, and repealing said original section.

An act relating to the validation of certain defective and irregular sheriffs' deeds, receivers' deeds, administrators' deeds, executors' deeds, and guardians' deeds recorded prior to January 1, 1934; amending section 67-263 of the General Statutes Supplement of 1961, and repealing said original section.

The members of the committee discussed in general the bills which are before the committee for their consideration.

The meeting adjourned at 9:45 A.M. The next regular meeting will be announced.
