SENATE WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE

Minutes of the Meeting March 28, 1963

The meeting was called to order by Acting Chairman Smith at 10:00 a.m., March 28, 1963. All members were present except Senators Farmer and Hults.

Senator Ward presented the subcommittee's report on House Bill No. 441. Changes made from the Governor's recommended budget by the House were enumerated. The subcommittee concurred in their recommendations, except Item 11, to the State Board of Registration for Cosmetologists. The House has approved an increase of \$6,235 over the Governor's recommendations to the Cosmetologists, for the hiring of an additional inspector. However, upon information furnished the House Ways and Means Committee, without additional money to hire a Clerk-Typist II the Board "is not anxious to have this . . . inspector".

Senator Warden made a motion, seconded by Senator Warren, that House Bill No. 441, Section 11, be amended by changing the amount of \$55,743 to \$49,508; thereby reducing the amount by \$6,235. Motion carried.

Senator Harper moved, and Senator Glades seconded the motion, that an additional amount of \$2,500 be allowed the Executive Gouncil (included in House Bill No. 441, Section 4), as a line item, for the installation of water heating equipment for Statehouse restrooms. Senator Sanborn made a substitute motion that the original \$5,000 appropriated for this project be reallowed, and any balances be lapsed. There being no second to his motion, it failed. Senator Harper's motion was then voted upon, and the motion carried.

Senator Ward moved, and Senator Harper seconded the motion, that House Bill No. 441 be recommended for passage as amended. Motion carried.

Senator Van Sickle moved, and Senator Sanborn seconded the motion, that House Bill No. 330 be recommended for passage. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
